The group will meet on the 1st and 3rd Monday of each month from 11:00 a.m. to 12:00 p.m. starting in October (2019). In this group, attendees can share the challenges and successes of coping with mental illness while offering encouragement and hope. It is free of charge. The meeting space is located on the first-floor classroom of Trinity Chapel at 10 West Church St. Trinity Chapel is the downtown church with a clock on its steeple. Enter through the main front door and the support group room is on the right.

**NAMI Connection is a free recovery support group for people living with mental illness in which people learn from each other's experiences, share coping strategies, and offer each other encouragement and understanding.**
